

TRY A NEW STITCH

Antwerp Edging

Antwerp Edging Stitch (also known as Knot Stitch Edging) is great to use on ATCs, bookmarks, etc. It can be found on page 19 of the *100 Stitches Embroidery Book*.

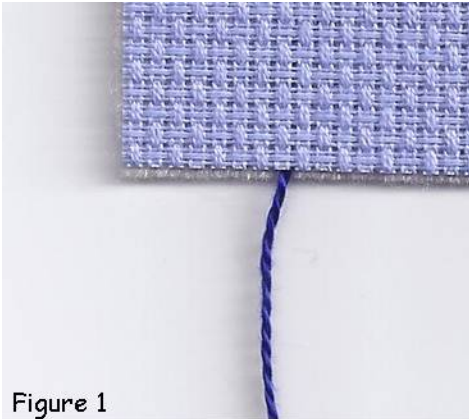

Anchor the thread and bring it out at the hem edge.

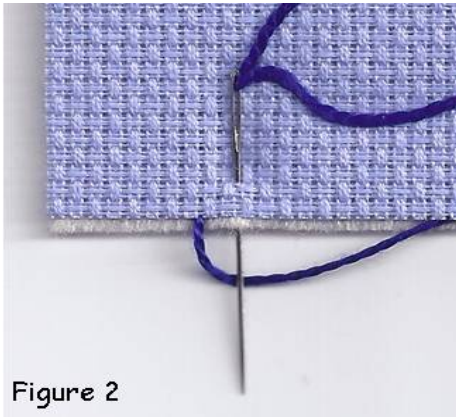

Take the needle through the fabric. Make sure the thread is under the needle. Pull the thread through.

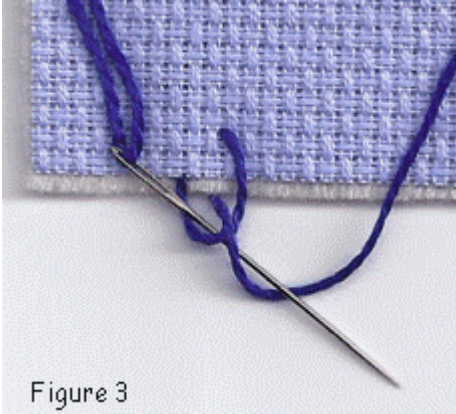

Take the needle behind the two threads making sure the working thread is under the needle. Pull the thread through and tighten to form a knot. Continue working along the hem edge.

To finish, take the needle through the hem edge and secure the thread.
