





Drench yourself in warm melon, bronze and cream hues with a whisper of verdant green in this uplifting canvaswork embroidery design. Worked on #18 mono canvas, it marries ThreadworX overdyed floss and metallic braids with DMC pearl cotton, Rainbow Gallery silk and rayon, Caron Impressions and Kreinik metallic threads, then crowns the piece with scattered beads and lustrous pearls.

A soft, mottled background gives way to layered and laid work and a rich tapestry of stitches: from padded and slanted Gobelin stitch to Milanese, rice, eyelet, Hungarian, and lattice work, among others.

Follow the charts, step-by-step instructions and insider tips to recreate the exact look using the threads shown in the photo, or switch things up entirely by raiding your own stash and stitching with the colours you love. Whether you stick to the recommended palette or make it your own, this intermediate-to-advanced pattern promises endless creative satisfaction.

Size of Design Area: 144 × 144 stitches; 8" × 8" on 18-count mono canvas

Supplies: Zweigart 18-count mono canvas in eggshell, 13" x 13", DMC floss, #5 & #12 pearl cotton, ThreadworX overdyed floss, #8 and #12 braids, Rainbow Gallery Neon Rays, Splendor & Flair, Kreinik #8 braid, Caron Collection Impressions (Approximately \$130 if purchasing the threads and fabric recommended.)

Time to complete: Approximately 75h
