Wendy Innes invites you to explore the shimmer of goldwork and the sculptural charm of stumpwork in a festive design that glows with tradition and sparkle. Learn to couch shimmering letters, craft and attach raised holly leaves, and master techniques like brick stitching Japan gold threads, couching pearl purl, and applying beads and spangles. With twinkling stars overhead and glistening berries below, this project is a celebration of texture, technique, and holiday joy

Project Details

Stitches: couching, brick stitch, satin stitch, buttonhole stitch and beading

Kit Contents: Red silk ground, quilter's muslin backing, cotton for detached elements, metal & silk threads, beads & spangles, needle pack, wire

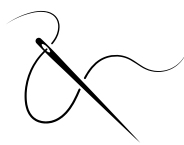
Supplies Needed:

- 25 cm (10") embroidery hoop
- 10 cm (4") embroidery hoop
- mechanical pencil or Friction pen
- fine tweezers
- embroidery scissors
- scissors to cut metal threads and wire
- 35 cm (14") square of lightweight cotton
- fabric (colour does not matter; will be discarded upon completion)
- Recommended: awl, mellor, velvet board
- scissors to cut metal threads
