Clear diagrams make it easy to relax into the rhythm, letting *Onyx* grow into a vibrant piece that's simply a pleasure to stitch.

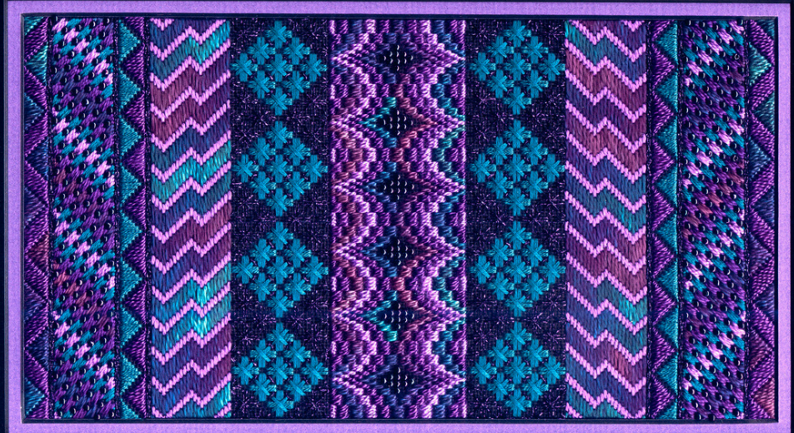
Stitches: bargello, double straight cross stitch variation, satin stitch, staggered mosaic variation, elongated cross stitch, beading

Kit: none

Supplies List:

- 38 cm x 28 cm (15" x 11") stretcher bars and tacks
- 38 cm x 28 cm (15" x 11") 24 count congress cloth **or** 25 count Lugana in black
- Caron Collection Watercolours
- DMC #5 pearl cotton
- DMC embroidery floss
- Kreinik #4 metallic braid
- Mill hill beads
- Trolley needle or laying tool
- Magnification and lighting (recommended)
