

# Queen of Stitches Scissor Envelope

This is a good project to use up those smaller bits of linen, threads and left-over beads. The materials that I used in the stitched samples were all bits and pieces left over from other projects. I was inspired by a pansy that I received at a local job fair at which my company had a table. You may be inspired by another colour scheme or use colours that make you happy.

This project was the winning entry in the 2016 EAC Board Challenge. A scissor fob and needlebook were part of Bonnie-Lynne's entry. You can find the charts for those pieces in *Embroidery Canada*, Spring 2017, Vol. 44, No. 3, pages 16-20.



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### Materials

- 32 count linen – soft green
- Caron Soie Cristale #6042 and #4005
- Rainbow Gallery Splendor #S1064
- Kreinik #4 Braid #002
- Wool felt for lining
- Crown charm or closure of choice

### Stitching

- 128 by 128 threads – basting line (this will be backstitched at the end)
- All stitching is 2 over 2 (all squares on the graph equal 2 linen threads)
